3. The Crucial Windows Fix (Do this before installing!) For Moodle 5.1 to work on Windows MAMP, you need to change one setting or the installation will freeze.

- o Open MAMP.
- o Go to File > Edit Template > PHP (php.ini).
- o Press Ctrl+F and search for: **max_input_vars**.
- o Change the value from **1000** to **5000** (and remove the **;** if you see one at the start of the line).
- o Save the file and Restart the servers in MAMP.

4. Create your Database

- o Go to <http://localhost:8888/phpMyAdmin> in your browser.
- o Click Databases (top tab).
- o Name it **moodle** and select **utf8mb4_unicode_ci** as the type.
- o Click Create.

The Moodle4Mac package has Moodle pre-installed inside of ' which is why it opens automatically for me in the video.

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1. Delete the current MAMP folder from your Applications (this is important so they don't conflict).
2. Go to this link: <https://download.moodle.org/macosx/>
3. Download the Moodle 5.1 package (it will be a .dmg file).
4. Open that file and drag the MAMP folder into your Applications.

Now, when you run MAMP and click "WebStart," it will take you straight to your Moodle site automatically.




